## GENERAL INFORMATION

Please dress your children in weather appropriate, comfortable clothes. During the winter by law, we must go out, and during the summer we often look for the puddle jumping opportunities. Please do not dress your child in clothes that you wish to have their pictures taken in. This Center is a hands on facility, the children should be free to explore their environment and to engage in painting, water play, play dough projects, etc., without worry of dirtying up their clothes. A change of clothes is also advisable for all seasons and can be left at the Center until they are used, at which time will be sent home for laundering. Parents will be notified in writing of any changes in operational policies.

Please do not bring any toys from home. If your child has a particular "warm and fuzzy" that helps them fall asleep, please feel free to bring it.

All the areas used for the Center are always open to anyone of the children's parents during normal hours of operation. We encourage parental involvement in the Center. Through out the year we will be inviting you to different functions we will be holding at the center, and hope you will be able to attend. If you have a talent you would like to share with the children, we would love to have you. Contact one of the staff to schedule a day to come in. All employed infant and toddler teachers have attended SIDS classes as required by the state.
